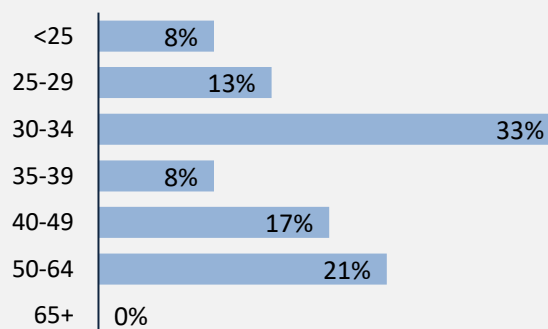

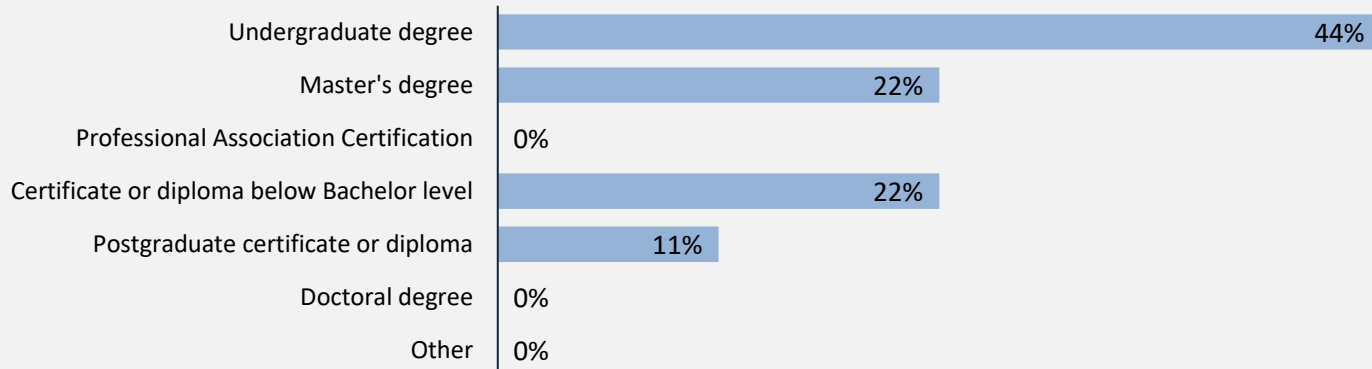

Type of further education



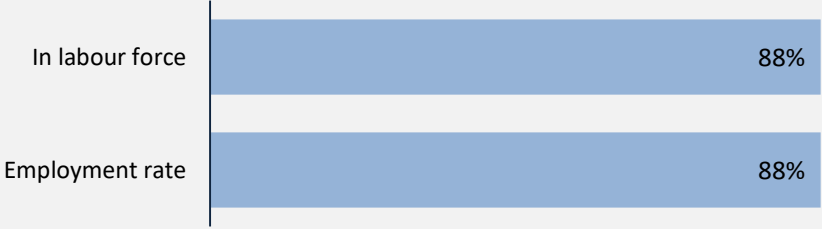

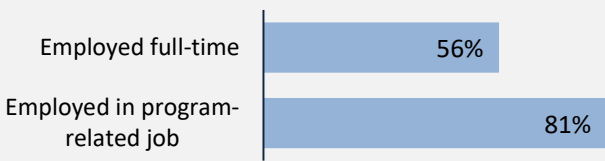

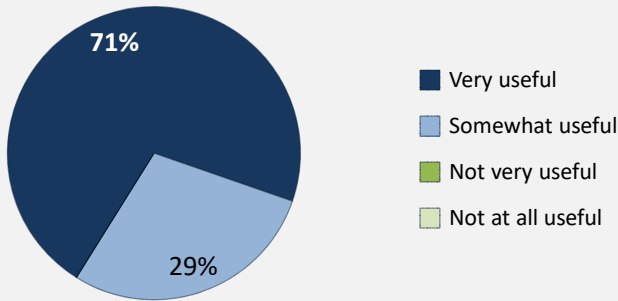

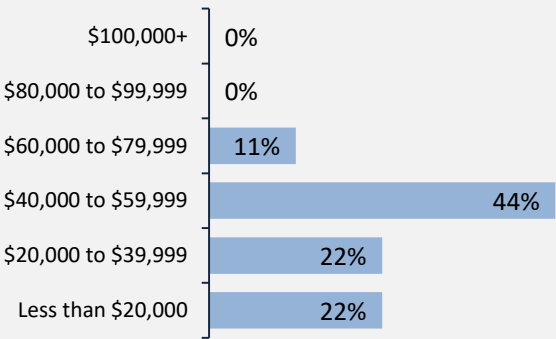

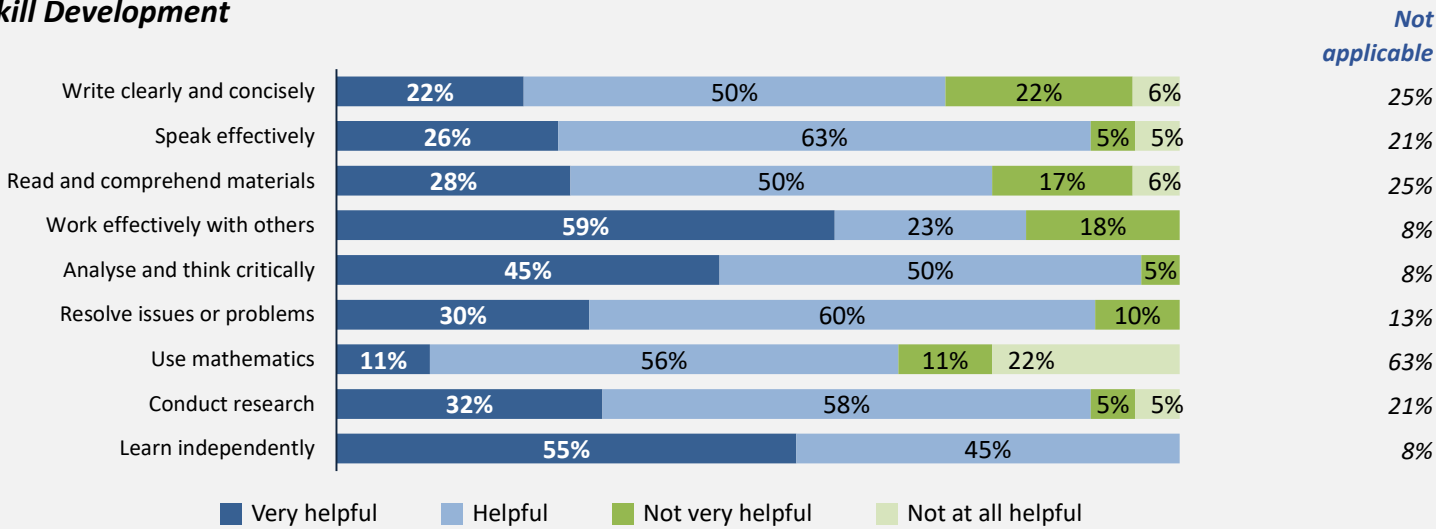

Skill Development and Post-Secondary Experience

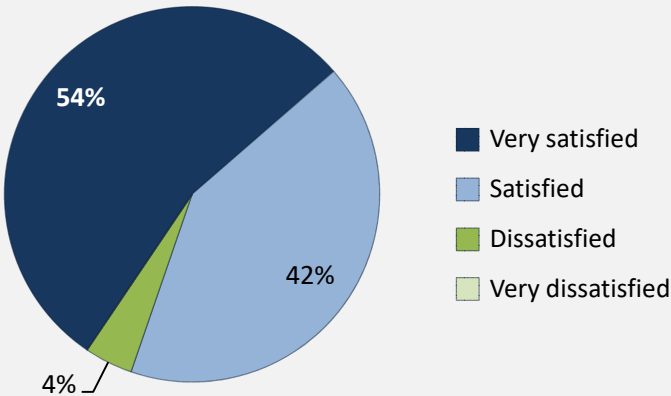
86% of respondents said they would choose the same program again
